

Middle Nene Archaeological Group

Rules

- 1. All members will do their best to help the Group achieve the aims set down in the constitution and shall consider the Group and its members first, rather than use the Group for personal gain.
- 2. All members shall gain permission from landowners, farmers or other persons concerned before entering fields or other property in the name of the Group, and shall not shelter under the name of the Group while engaged in other pursuits.
- 3. No member shall engage in any excavation in the name of the Group without first obtaining the permission of the committee.
- 4. All objects discovered belong to the landowner. Important finds should be declared to the landowner and agreement sought about the final resting place. All finds which may qualify as treasure should be reported to the local Finds Liaison Officer through the Portable Antiquities Scheme.
- 5. All excavations organised by the Group shall be in the charge of an experienced/responsible person.
- 6. The committee shall have the right to reprimand any member transgressing the rules and any such member may have to forfeit membership.
